THE DONALD C. AND MARION E. CURRIER SCHOLARSHIP

of the Community Foundation of St. Joseph County

(Application due June 1)

Donald Clarence Currier was awarded a degree with distinction from the Purdue University School of Mechanical Engineering on June 15, 1926. Seventy-three years later, his wife Marion established The Donald C. and Marion E. Currier Scholarship in his memory to benefit students from St. Joseph County, Indiana. Students pursuing degrees from the College of Engineering at Purdue University in ANY engineering field, with the exception of Engineering Education, are eligible.

This generous scholarship will provide **up to** full tuition and required fees, an allowance for books up to \$1,000 per year, and an on-campus or off-campus living allowance up to \$8,000 per year. The scholarship, which typically commences when the student officially enters the engineering program in his/her sophomore year, may be renewable for up to six semesters. Work/study semesters do not count toward this limit. The scholarship is suspended during work/study participation. The student may request funding over a summer semester but are advised this will count as one full semester and reduce eligibility for future semesters accordingly.

Applications are due through the Community Foundation's online scholarship system by June 1 following the applicant's freshman year, with funding commencing in the fall of their sophomore year. Students must have completed at least one year at Purdue before they may apply. Upper-class students who can demonstrate outstanding academic achievement may submit an application for their junior and/or senior years.

ELIGIBILITY

Student must:

- have been be a resident of St. Joseph County, Indiana during high school
- have graduated from a St. Joseph County, Indiana high school
- be accepted by the Purdue University West Lafayette College of Engineering and intend to pursue a full-time baccalaureate course of study in any engineering field, excluding Engineering Education. *(Please note: Those pursuing degrees through Purdue University regional campuses or Purdue Polytechnic Institute are not eligible as these programs are separate from the West Lafayette College of Engineering.)*
- maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0.

Eligibility Note: Family members of those serving on the scholarship nomination committee or Community Foundation staff are deemed ineligible (defined as spouses, lineal descendants and their spouses, siblings and their spouses).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Complete the Donald C. and Marion E. Currier Scholarship Application through the [online scholarship system](http://www.cfsjc.org/scholarshipapp) (www.cfsjc.org/scholarshipapp).
- One letter of recommendation from a person in a leadership position who knows you well. This should be submitted through the online scholarship system.
- Transcript from high school and your current college transcript indicating a 3.0 cumulative GPA at Purdue University. These should be uploaded as part of the application.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Additional information that has not been requested will not be accepted. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. There will be no exceptions.** The online application must be complete and submitted by **June 1 at 11:59 p.m.** It is the responsibility of the student to ensure the application is complete and all materials are received on or before the deadline.
